effective yesterday. She served in the government for 36 years before retiring on Aug 15, 2018, and currently sits on the board of Bank Islam Malaysia Bhd, Sirim Bhd and Zurich Takaful Ma-

The Pharmaniaga chairman's position was left vacated after Tan Sri Che Lodin Wok Kamaruddin stepped down as LTAT CEO in September last year, simultaneously relinquishing his four top positions in LTAT-controlled public-listed companies including Pharmaniaga.

Besides Hafsah, Pharmaniaga also announced the appointment of four new directors to the board. They are former health director-general (DG) Tan Sri Dr Mohamed Ismail Merican, who is now Mahsa University pro-chancellor and chairman, Shahrom & Co Advocates & Solicitors founding and managing partner
