OCK GROUP PROVIDES UPDATE ON MYANMAR EARTHQUAKE IMPACT, ASSURES MINIMAL DISRUPTION TO OPERATIONS

2 APRIL 2025, SHAH ALAM – OCK Group Berhad (“OCK” or the “Group”), Malaysia's largest telecommunications network solutions provider and regional towerco, today provided an update on the recent earthquake that affected Myanmar, and its potential impact on OCK Myanmar's operations.

In light of the recent earthquake in Myanmar, OCK would like to provide an update regarding the impact on OCK Myanmar's operations.

First and foremost, the Group is relieved to confirm that all OCK Myanmar staff are safe and accounted for following the earthquake. The well-being of our employees is our top priority, and we are committed to ensuring their safety during this challenging time.

The earthquake's epicenter was located in the northern part of Myanmar, near Mandalay. We would like to report that approximately 90% of OCK Myanmar's tower sites are situated in suburban and rural areas, which are significantly less affected by the seismic activity compared to urban centers. This geographical positioning has greatly minimized the potential for disruptions to our network and operations.

Our operations team has been proactive in conducting a thorough inspection of our tower infrastructure. As of today, we have inspected 95% of our sites, and the results are largely favorable. Only four towers have been identified as requiring dismantling due to damage sustained from the earthquake.

Importantly, none of the ground-based towers that have been assessed so far have shown any significant damage that would impact their functionality or the network's performance.

While further inspections will continue over the next few days to ensure that all sites are thoroughly evaluated, we do not anticipate any major long-term impact on OCK Myanmar's operations or business performance. The Group's regional presence and diverse tower portfolio continue to provide resilience, and we remain confident in our ability to maintain service continuity in Myanmar.

We would also like to extend our thoughts and best wishes to the people of Myanmar during this difficult time. Our hearts go out to those affected by this disaster, and we stand with the nation in the recovery process.
