**- MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN UNIVERSITY MALAYSIA OF COMPUTER SCIENCE AND ENGINEERING AND INFOLINE IT SOLUTIONS SDN. BHD., A WHOLLY-OWNED SUBSIDIARY OF THE COMPANY**

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## **1. INTRODUCTION**

The Board of Directors of Infoline is pleased to announce that Infoline IT Solutions Sdn. Bhd. ("**Infoline IT**"), a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company, has on 23 July 2025 entered into a Memorandum of Understanding ("**MOU**") with University Malaysia of Computer Science and Engineering [Registration No. DU040(B)] ("**UNIMY**") to foster and strengthen educational value and collaboration in the Information Technology ("**IT**") world and to establish a basis of co-operation and collaboration between Infoline IT and UNIMY (hereinafter be referred to singularly as "**the Party**" and jointly as "**the Parties**").

## **2. INFORMATION ON INFOLINE IT AND UNIMY**

Infoline IT [Registration No. 201301015421 (1045254-P)], a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company, is a private limited company incorporated in Malaysia and having its business address at No. 53-3, Jalan PJU 5/20E, Pusat Perdagangan Kota Damansara, 47810 Petaling Jaya, Selangor Darul Ehsan. Infoline IT is engaged in providing IT infrastructure solutions and managing cybersecurity services.

UNIMY is a private university incorporated under the laws of Malaysia and having its business address at Level 1 & 2, Block B, VSQ@PJ City Centre, Jalan Utara, Section 14, 46200 Petaling Jaya, Selangor Darul Ehsan. UNIMY is a premier education provider under the Brickfields Asia College (BAC) Education Group, operating the university at its business address and aims to provide quality higher education in Malaysia which includes pre-university, undergraduate, postgraduate and professional courses in engineering and IT, amongst others.

## **3. SALIENT TERMS OF THE MOU**

The salient terms as extracted from the MOU include, inter-alia, the following: -

### **(a) Scope of Co-Operation**

Each Party will endeavour to take necessary steps to encourage and develop academic exchange in the areas of IT and cybersecurity, and have agreed on the activities as set out below:-

- (i) The Parties will collaborate to develop a dedicated cybersecurity laboratory and Security Operations Centre ("**SOC**") on UNIMY's campus;
- (ii) Infoline IT will provide training to UNIMY students at the said laboratory and SOC;
- (iii) UNIMY students will be granted access to Infoline IT's Artificial Intelligence (AI) Platform for academic research purposes. The Parties will identify opportunities to turn the research output into commercially viable solutions. Any intellectual property rights shall be dealt with in accordance with the provisions in the MOU; and
- (iv) Infoline IT will provide internships and job placement opportunities for students of UNIMY, subject to availability.

The Parties agree that the list of activities set out above is not exhaustive and may be added from time to time as jointly decided by the Parties.

**(b) Duration of MOU**

The MOU comes into effect on the date of execution and will remain in effect for a period of one (1) year. The MOU may be extended for a further period as may be agreed in writing by the Parties. Either Party may terminate the MOU by giving to the other Party a written notice of at least three (3) months prior to the intended termination date.

**(c) Implementation**

Each Party agrees to appoint an Administrative Coordinator for the administration of the MOU. The Administrative Coordinators will serve as the contact persons responsible for implementing the decisions and ensuring that necessary approvals are in place to carry out the proposed activities and overseeing the productive stay of the visiting experts and arrangements associated with their visits.

**(d) Intellectual Property Rights**

The intellectual property rights in respect of any technological development, and any products and services development, developed:-

- (i) jointly by the Parties, or research results obtained through the joint activity effort of the Parties, will be addressed on a case-by-case basis under separate written agreements;
- (ii) solely and separately by the UNIMY or Infoline IT, any research results obtained through the sole and separate effort of UNIMY or Infoline IT, as the case may be, will be solely owned by the Party concerned; and
- (iii) rights in intellectual property developed by the students of UNIMY in the course of exchanges, collaboratively or research activities will be dealt with in accordance with the national laws, rules and regulations, the respective policies of the Parties and/or separate written agreements.

The use of either Party's name, logo, or official emblem is prohibited without prior written approval.

**(e) FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS**

The MOU will not give rise to any financial obligation by one Party to the other and each Party will bear its own cost and expenses in relation to the academic activities under the MOU.

**4. FINANCIAL EFFECTS OF THE MOU**

The MOU is not expected to have any material immediate effect on the earnings per share, net assets per share and gearing of the Company and its subsidiaries ("**Group**") for the financial year ending 31 March 2026, but is expected to contribute positively to the Group's future earnings and cash flow position.

**5. INTEREST OF THE DIRECTORS, MAJOR SHAREHOLDERS, AND/OR PERSONS CONNECTED WITH THEM**

None of the Directors, major shareholders, and/or any persons connected to them have any interest, either direct or indirect, in the MOU.

## **6. DIRECTORS' STATEMENT**

The Board of Directors of Infoline, having taken into consideration all aspects of the MOU, is of the opinion that the MOU will have a positive impact on the business of the Company and is in the best interest of the Group.
