### ACCEPTANCE OF LETTER OF AWARD

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

The Board of Directors of EIB (“**Board**”) wishes to announce that its wholly-owned subsidiary, Ecoscience Manufacturing & Engineering Sdn. Bhd. had on 12 September 2025 accepted a letter of award for the construction and installation work of the proposed palm oils & fats refinery plant in Johor from an oil process engineering company to undertake the construction of building and infrastructure, and installation works for the proposed palm oils & fats refinery plant (“**Works Contract**”).

#### 2. INFORMATION OF THE WORKS CONTRACT

The amount for the Works Contract is RM40.00 million and is expected to be completed on or before 1 July 2026.

#### 3. RISK FACTORS

There is no foreseeable significant risks other than operational risk associated with the Works Contract during the project’s duration.

#### 4. FINANCIAL EFFECTS

Barring any unforeseen circumstances, the Works Contract is expected to contribute positively to the Company and will not have any effect on the share capital and substantial shareholders’ shareholdings of EIB.

#### 5. INTEREST OF DIRECTORS AND/OR MAJOR SHAREHOLDERS AND/OR PERSONS CONNECTED WITH THEM

None of the Directors and/or major shareholders of the Company and/or persons connected with them has any interest, direct or indirect, in the Works Contract.

#### 6. DIRECTORS’ STATEMENT

The Board, after due consideration, is of the opinion that the Works Contract is in the best interest of the Company. The Works Contract being entered into is in the ordinary course of business and it is not subject to the approval of shareholders.
