KUALA LUMPUR, 6th October 2025 – Citaglobal Bhd's indirect wholly-owned subsidiary, Citaglobal Bioenergy Sdn Bhd ("Citaglobal Bioenergy") and Keppel Decarb (Malaysia) Sdn Bhd ("Keppel") have signed a Joint Development Agreement (JDA) to collaborate on bio-compressed natural gas (Bio-CNG) projects in Malaysia, subject to conditions precedent being fulfilled by both parties. The collaboration aims to advance Malaysia's green energy agenda by transforming agricultural waste and palm oil effluent into clean, renewable energy that can be used to power industries and drive economic growth.

On Monday, Citaglobal and Keppel formalised the JDA at a signing ceremony event in Kuantan, Pahang. The JDA signing ceremony was graced by His Royal Highness the Sultan of Pahang, Al-Sultan Abdullah Ri'ayatuddin Al-Mustafa Billah Shah.

Citaglobal Bioenergy is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Citaglobal Environment Management Sdn Bhd, the wholly-owned environment and waste management arm of Citaglobal Bhd that undertakes all environment, waste management and related businesses for the Group.

Through this JDA, Citaglobal aspires to be a leader in Malaysia's Bio-CNG sector, while leveraging Keppel Decarb's extensive expertise in decarbonisation and renewable energy infrastructure.

The collaboration with Keppel is expected to be part of the proposed *Citaglobal Bioenergy & Green Eco Park*, an anchor component of an upcoming 247-acre industrial park project in Gebeng, Pahang, that will be developed by Citaglobal. The industrial park will be located in the Gebeng Industrial Estate, an established industrial hub with excellent access to key infrastructure, including ports, highways, and the upcoming East Coast Rail Link (ECRL).

The Citaglobal Bioenergy & Green Eco Park will reinforce Pahang's position as a leader in sustainable growth and industrial innovation. Integrating renewable energy with green design features such as sustainable water management and eco-friendly building elements, the park will operate on a zero-waste, circular economy model that integrates energy recovery and resource efficiency.
