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NexG Bags RM733mil Contract To Suply National ID Cards



NexG, through its subsidiary, has been the provider of MyKad solutions since 1999.

KUALA LUMPUR: NexG Bhd's unit Datasonic Technologies Sdn Bhd has been awarded a contract from the National Registration Department to supply national identity cards worth RM733 million.

The six-year contract will commence on June 1 next year.

This follows the RM1.73 billion Malaysia international passport supply contract secured on August 29.

NexG, through its subsidiary, has been the provider of MyKad solutions since 1999.

Under the contract, the government will introduce a next-generation upgraded MyKad with enhanced durability and multi-layered security features.

NesG said the new design was developed to resist forgery, protect against tampering and ensure long-term reliability while enabling the rakyat to participate securely in the digital economy.

NexG executive chairman and group chief executive officer Abu Hanifah Noordin said the contract reflects the government's vision and commitment to provide Malaysians with a next-generation identity card that goes beyond identification.
