## **NexG Launches Its Own MyNasional Private Digital ID Platform**

KUALA LUMPUR (Sept 24): NexG Bhd (KL:NEXG), formerly Datasonic Group Bhd, on Wednesday unveiled its own digital identity platform known as MyNasional.

The company is marketing MyNasional as a platform that unifies biometric electronic know-your-customer for secure identity, artificial intelligence (AI) and data intelligence to

government agencies, small and medium businesses, and national programmes. Future plans include expansion into logistics fulfilment and digital payments.

The initiative marks NexG's shift from production of secured physical documents to broader digital ecosystem development, deputy chairman Tan Sri Mohd Khairul Adib Abd Rahman said at the launch event of MyNasional.

App deployment will be anchored by MyNasional eKYC Holdings Sdn Bhd, formerly Innov8tif Holdings Sdn Bhd, in which NexG holds a 51% stake following its RM40 million cash acquisition from Revenue Group Bhd (KL:REVENUE) in November last year.

NexG is touting the initiative as a privately funded venture, requiring no government contracts or budget allocations to accelerate e-government adoption and digital transformation while allowing public resources to be redirected to other priorities.

Capital expenditure plans are yet to be finalised, as the company remains in advanced discussions with key stakeholders.

NexG is engaged in discussions with government agencies to make digital ID more pervasive in everyday transactions, said chief strategy officer Jorrine Ang.

She noted that the company's acquisition of MMAG Holdings Bhd (KL:MMAG) will support logistics and delivery needs, completing the MyNasional ecosystem.

"Secure documents must be delivered reliably — that's where logistics comes in. We're building first- and last-mile capabilities to support secure delivery, eKYC onboarding and app-based integration," Ang added.

To support the initiative, NexG has signed a memorandum of understanding with state-owned Mimos Holdings Bhd to explore joint ventures in AI-driven border security, behavioural profiling and public service automation.

Additionally, a letter of intent with Universiti Teknologi Malaysia will launch the first initiative under Yayasan MyNasional, a foundation being established to nurture Malaysia's digital talent through research in AI, eKYC, digital identity and cyber security.
